## GENERAL RULES:

All Rules and Regulations as found on pages 60 - 64 will apply to all classes as necessary, in addition to any rules listed below.

Please use the **Orange Livestock Entry Form** included in this book (*forms obtained outside of this book may not be orange*) to list your entries and mail with **proof of insurance, W-9 form, camping application** and any **fees** to the above address.

### Entry:

\$5.00 entry fee per class.

### Judging:

Judges/flagman decision will be final. Any disagreement on their decision on any point of controversy will result in disqualification for that class for the day.

No portion of the tractor shall interfere with the sled hitch during pull.

Any portion of the tractor touching the boundary line during pull will result in end of pull.

Two attempts will be allowed to start sled except in pull off's. One attempt only is a pull off.

The first puller can drop five places or they can come back immediately if they refuse the pull. If they do drop, they drop to the sixth position. If a puller has mechanical problems, they drop to the rear.

Driver will be disqualified if he/she delays contest. Puller is expected to have tractor running and be prepared to hook when drag returns to starting point.

A driver must remain seated during pull and must have at least one hand on the steering wheel at all times.

Weight transfer sled will be used with a twelve inch hitch height.

Tractors must be operated in a safe manner and at a safe speed at all times.

All weights must be safely secured to the tractor. Any loss of weights or components may be cause for disqualification.

Competitors must be at least 5 years old and no older than 19 years old at first pull of season.

One tractor per driver per class.

All tractors must use stock rear end for model of tractor.

Maximum wheel base of 52 ½ inches. Exception: Pure Stock class wheel base must remain stock.
