STOCK FARM TRACTOR PULLING

Entry Fee is \$15.00 per class.

Skowhegan State Fair assumes no responsibility for loss, theft and/or injury to any participants or property.

Contests open to tractors with rubber tires. No four wheel drives allowed. No dual tires, tire studs or chains permitted. All power must be transmitted to the wheels.

Drivers 16 and 17 years of age are permitted to pull with parental permission. Drivers 18 and older are not required to have parental permission.

Tires:

Classes 1 to 5 & 7 must not exceed the maximum tire size of 18.4". Classes 8 to 12 must not exceed the maximum tire size of 20.8". Classes 6 & 13 are HOT STOCK classes & must not exceed the maximum tire size of 24.5".

Only one driver may drive the same tractor in each class.

Driver must not leave seat of tractor while pulling.

No dealer will be eligible to enter a tractor in the contest.

Weight of tractor shall include the driver.

All tractors must be stock and must weigh out after each pull.

Top place a dyno in Nebraska (Nebraska reference) **We will not be using a dyno in 2017** **checked on horsepower is a reference**

Chain must be hooked to the following drawbar specifications. Minimum drawbar length 18" from center of rear wheel to point of hook, measured horizontally. Drawbar to be stationary in all directions. Maximum height of 20" from top of hitching device parallel to ground. Drawbar must be rigid in all directions and parallel to the ground. Drawbar must be equipped with a steel hitching device not more than 1" thickness and with a 3" diameter opening. Cross sectional thickness must be 7/8" minimum. Pulling point may not be more than 1 1/2" from back edge of hitching device. No supports attached to drawbar. No weight beyond 2 feet of front end.

Class will be canceled if no entries are made in said class.

No portion of tractor may interfere with the sled or sled hitch during pull.

All weight must be safety secured to tractor, must remain stationary and must not protrude more than 6" beyond rear tires.

All tractors must be equipped with workable rear wheel brakes.

All tractors must have a strong and rigid seat. All tip seats must be securely fastened while pulling; seats will be thoroughly inspected by officials.

The Fair Association strongly recommends the use of stabilizer bars.

All tires will turn in correct rotation.

In case of dispute or misunderstanding, the decision of the judges or superintendents will be considered fair, impartial and final.

Any tractors pulling in an inappropriate class will be disqualified for that class and will not be able to win previous or following class premiums.
