### GENERAL RULES:

All Rules and Regulations as found on pages 54 - 60 will apply to all classes as necessary, in addition to any rules listed below.

Please use the Barrell Racing Entry **Form** included in this book to list your entries and mail with proof of insurance, **W-9 form,** to the address on the form.

### \*\*Rules subject to change without notice\*\*

(Rules will be enforced and are subject to change or added at any time)

Contestants may not enter the show grounds before 11:00 A.M. in order to allow for the cattle to leave. No overnight stabling. Failure to comply with this rule will automatically disqualify you from showing.

Fair officials have the right to assign parking if necessary. Any disagreements will be an automatic disqualification from show-

Entry fees must be paid in CASH before the start of the first class.

Proper western attire is required for all events. Western boots, clean jeans or pants, and a western hat or helmet must he worn.

A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed if the rider's hat hits the ground before crossing the finish line, or if it falls back off the head before crossing the starting line. This fee must be paid before competing in another class.

Any contestant damaging the timer or property will be responsible for the repair or replacement.

A horse may only be entered once in each

Excessive whipping, spurring, or hitting the horse in front of the girth will not be permitted, either in the show ring or outside of the ring!

Date & Time: Starting at 9:00 am Saturday August 19th

Cannot enter grounds until 11:00 am to allow for cattle to leave.

A person arriving at a show with an underweight animal or an animal in obvious poor health or one being mistreated/abused will be asked to take the animal home immediately.

An office fee of \$5.00 will be collected from each horse and rider combination.

A one minute time limit will be given to enter the ring, with a 30-second warning. A rider who is not ready to go in within the one minute time limit will be disqualified. Riders who are ready, but fail to enter the ring because their horse is uncooperative will be given a second chance at the end of the class. A rider who breaks the timer before the ring is ready will be disqualified.

A knocked barrel or pole will count as a no time in all classes.

Purses for 4-D classes will be split 50% to the 1st division, 30% to the 2nd division, 20% to the 3rd division, and 10% to the 4th division. Payouts in each division will be to third place. Money will be split 50% for 1st place, 30% for 2nd place, and 20% for third.

Points towards the All-Around Speed Event Champion will be calculated by the number of people signed up for all five classes. (If 20 horses are in the class, but only 10 are signed up to qualify for the All-Around Speed Event Champion, then points will only be given as if there were 10 entrants in the class).

Ties will be handled as follows: instead of a run-off, the two places that would have been decided by a run-off will combine and split the prize money evenly.
