No entries will be admitted after 6:00 pm on August 8, 2023.

All articles must be the work of the exhibitor and strictly homemade. All canned goods must be from August 2022 to August 2023 and exhibited in colorless glass canning jars. Canned goods will be opened at discretion of judges. Only listed varieties will be accepted. Jars must be full and sealed. May be disqualified if older than August 2022.

All canned goods should be labeled as follows: Class, Category Number & Variety Number, name of product to be put on the side of jars; name and address on bottom of jars only. Ingredients in jars need to be uniform. Judged on color, uniformity & size.

Fifteen (15) entries within Dept. 1 will be required in order to receive 1 Season Pass, NO exceptions. Children under 12 who enter less than 15 items in Dept. 1 will receive one (1) day pass, NO exceptions.
