All Rules and Regulations as found on pages 54 - 60 will apply to all classes as necessary, in addition to any rules listed below.

****Rules subject to change without notice****

At a signal, each contestant must attempt to catch a pig and place it in a sack, which will be provided by the fair.

Each scramble will have 5 pigs and 10 children. There are one set of Scrambles for each age group. Names will be drawn from a hat for each age group.

Children who do not catch a pig will receive a \$5.00 gratuity.

Contestants may sign up at the fair Livestock Office, during office hours August 10 - 18.

STATE OF MAINE - RULES

1. The person in charge of the event shall be responsible for the animals being "well cared for" prior to, during and after the event until such time as the new owners remove the animals from the premises.

2. No lubricant may be used on the pig or the contestant.

3. The pigs shall not weigh less than 16 lbs (sixteen pounds) for 8-10 age group and not less than 22 lbs (twenty-two pounds) for 10-12 age groups.

4. The contestants shall not be over the age of 12.

5. The event shall not last more than 10 (ten) minutes.

6. The bags or sacks used shall be burlap to give the animal adequate breathing and cooling air.

7. The manager of the event shall have someone available to purchase or take the animals if an animal is caught by someone who does not have adequate facilities to care for the animals at their residence.

8. The area/ring being used will be no less than 3,000 square feet.

9. A pig may only be used for one event per day.
