All articles must be the work of the exhibitor and strictly homemade. only listed varieties will be accepted. **NO PACKAGE MIXES TO BE USED.**

Please use 6" to 8" paper pie plates.

Only clear plastic wrap, no colored plastic. Exhibitors are cautioned about the use of plastic wrap on cooked foods. If foods are not thoroughly cooled, it has a sogging effect and tends to collect moisture with temperature changes. Have food ready for display. No wrapping or rewrapping of food in the building will be allowed.

Judged on texture, flavor, uniformity & moistness.

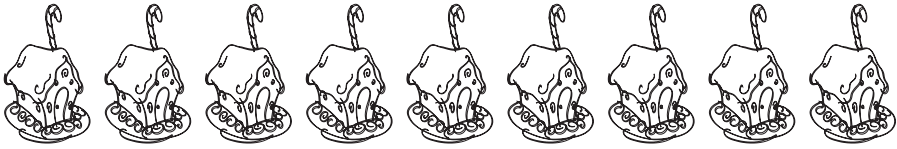

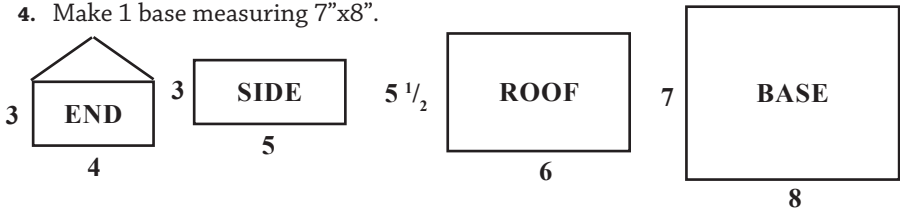

Base Material and Measurements:

1. Cut shapes from corrugated cardboard.
2. Secure with masking tape on all corners and seams.

Pattern:

1. Make 2 ends measuring 2"x3"x4".
2. Make 2 sides measuring 3"x5".
3. Make 1 roof measuring 5 1/2"x6". Score down center of 5 1/2" length
4. Make 1 base measuring 7"x8".

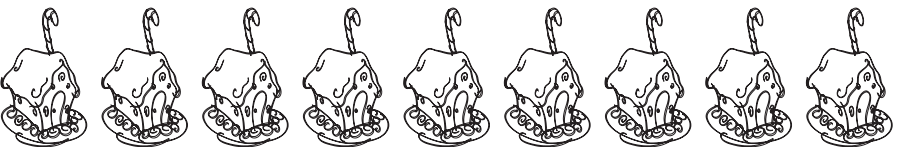


Frosting: Make the following recipe.

Combine 3 egg whites, at room temperature, one pound confection sugar (about 4 ³/₄ cups), one teaspoon of vanilla or water and ¹/₂ teaspoon of cream of tarter. Beat with an electric mixer 7 to 10 minutes or until frosting is very stiff. Keep frosting covered with a damp cloth at all times to prevent crust from forming.

Instructions:

1. Use the frosting as decoration and as glue.
2. Frosting may be colored.
3. Completely cover form.
4. Decorations must be **EDIBLE**.
5. Decorations can consist of - Candies, cookies, nuts, crackers, cereals, etc...
6. Decorations can be either store bought or homemade.
7. All decorations should be able to stand up under high temperature for 10 days.

Judging Guidelines: All pies must contain only blueberries. Pies made from a combination of fruits will be disqualified from judging (such pies will also be disqualified at the state level). The recipes must be cooked as submitted. Judges will eliminate from consideration any pie which obviously is not done as the written recipe states (ex.: a pie which contains raisins, but no raisins are listed in the written recipe).

Premiums

First — \$40.00

Second — \$25.00

Third — \$10.00

Winners receive ribbons.

Judging will be done in three basic categories as follows:

Appearance - Overall eye appeal, uniformity of shape and color and appearance of the crust

Taste - Crust and filling will be judged separately. In evaluating the crust, flavor, texture, and color will be considered. In evaluating the filling, flavor and consistency will be evaluated

Preparation - This will be determined from the written recipe which will accompany each entry. Ease of preparing the recipe and how clearly the recipe ingredients and instructions are written will be evaluated.

Scoring Guidelines: Supplied score sheets will be used. The categories will be rated as follows:

Overall Appearance - 30 points

Crust (flavor, texture, color) - 30 points

Filling (flavor, consistency) - 30 points

Ease of Preparation/Clarity of Recipe - 10 points.

Judges shall total the points for each entry. The contest coordinator will compile the judge's scores on a summary sheet. The positions will be determined by the total number of points given by all the judges. In the event two or more contestants have identical point totals, the judges shall determine the order of finish by mutual agreement. All decisions shall be final.
