GENERAL RULES:

All Rules and Regulations as found on pages 54 - 60 will apply to all classes as necessary, in addition to any rules listed below.

Please use the **Livestock Entry Form** included in this book to list your entries and mail with **proof of insurance, W-9 form, camping application** and any **fees** to the above address.

****Rules subject to change without notice****

Any additional rules provided by the Animal Welfare Board will take precedence and will be enforced.

Entry:

\$5.00 stalling fee per animal. Entries will be limited to 225 sheep. Family/Farm generations will be regarded as a separate Firm/Farm. Members of the same firm or the same farm within 1 generation, will be regarded as one exhibitor. Please send all entries to Show Manager at the address listed above. All checks are to be made payable to: Skowhegan State Fair.

Requirements:

All sheep must be registered. All animals entered must be purebred and must have at the time of entry or on request of proper officials a registration certificate for each animal issued by the association making such registration and must be registered in owner's name. Transfers must be signed by Secretary of Sheep Association. Each exhibitor is limited to showing no more than three breeds of his own, but may show flocks for others as well, as long as there are no more than three breeds from each farm, firm or family and as long as the care and condition of these animals are maintained.

Teeth:

Junior lambs must have all their lambs teeth. Lambs that are over eleven months of age may have 2 permanent teeth showing but not higher than their lambs teeth.

Yearlings must have no more than 4 permanent teeth.

Transportation:

All sheep must be in place Sunday, August 11th, by 12:00 pm. Sheep will be release on Saturday, August 17th, at 2:00 pm.

Premiums:

No premiums will be paid on grade males in compliance with state laws. Exhibitors receive only two premiums in a single class and one premium in a group class.

Judging:

Judging will take place on August 14th & August 15th at 10:00 am.

Show Ring:

Children under the age of 9 will not be allowed in the show ring.

Limit 5 passes/bracelets per farm.

Additional passes/bracelets based on number of sheep entries and must be pre-approved. Please list number of passes/bracelets needed on Entry Form.
