General Rules & Regulations

GENERAL RULES:

All Rules and Regulations as found on pages 54 - 60 will apply to all classes as necessary.

Please use the **Livestock Entry Form** (unless noted) included in this book to list your entries and mail with **proof of insurance, W-9 form, camping application** and any **fees** to the above address.

****Rules subject to change without notice****

Age Requirements:

Senior Members - Age 16-21.

Intermediate Members - Age 12-15.

Junior Members - Age 9-11.

Young Junior Members - Age 5-8.

Novice Member - Age 9-21, *someone who has never shown.*

Purebred Animals:

All animals entered as purebred must have at time of entry or on request of proper officials a registration certificate for each animal issued by the association making such registration and must be registered in owners name.

Showing & Care:

All exhibitors are required to care for and show their own animals.

If exhibitor has more than one animal in a class, he/she may ask another youth to assist in the showing. Youth may NOT ex-

hibit any more than two (2) animals in any one class & one (1) entry in any one Fitting & Showing. Animals may leave after they show.

Attire:

Beef & Sheep Shows:

Western attire is acceptable. Collared shirt, short or long sleeved & tucked in. Proper footwear is required.

Dairy Show:

Show whites required.
