****Rules subject to change without notice****

Any additional rules provided by the Animal Welfare Board will take precedence and will be enforced.

Show Rules:

Registration papers must be presented on all animals over 6 months of age. All animals under 6 months may be shown with a stamped duplicate registration.

No copies of registration papers will be accepted. Persons showing animals

whose papers have been signed for transfer but have not been processed for transfer by the ADGA/MDGA office must show those animals as agents for the current owner shown on ADGA/MDGA records.

Substitutions will only be accepted within a

given breed & class only.

Base date to determine age of animals will be August 15, 2026

Tattoos/Microchip must be legible to receive a leg on a championship.

All animals must be tattooed with assigned tattoo numbers or microchipped before arrival at the show. No tattoos or EIDs (microchips) should be applied at the show. Owners of animals with EID (microchips) must have a microchip reader available at the show.

Absolutely no smoking/vaping in the goat areas/shared spaces.

Animals with horns or scurs exceeding three inches are not acceptable for showing

ADGA Rules shall govern these shows

There will be no pre show milkout

Entries are unlimited (except for specialty classes)

Show order may be changed at the discretion of the show committee and/or judge

All animals may be inspected before they may be unloaded from the vehicles or trailers. If any animals show signs of abscess, sore mouth, pink eye, or other infectious or

contagious diseases, the entire herd will be asked to leave, and the entry fees forfeited.

Health regulations: Dairy Goats from all Maine counties may be shown provided the herd is not under quarantine. ALL OUT OF STATE EXHIBITORS MUST OBTAIN WRITTEN PERMITS, which can be obtained from the Division of Animal Husbandry, Department of Agriculture, Augusta, ME 04330. Permits and health papers must be checked prior to unloading. Health papers are required for all out of State animals and should be presented on arrival and at check-in.

ADGA Nigerians and MDGA Nigerians will be shown in separate classes.

Entry Fees: \$6 per animal if entry is received by August 1st
